The quantitative range of this test is 1.70-7.00 log copies/mL (50-10,000,000 copies/mL).

An interpretation of "Not Detected" does not rule out the presence of inhibitors or HIV-1 RNA concentration below the level of detection of the test. Care should be taken in the interpretation of any single viral load determination.

The clinical significance of changes in HIV-1 RNA concentration has not been fully established; however, a change of 0.5 log copies/mL may be significant.

This assay should not be used for blood donor screening, associated reentry protocols, or for screening human cell-, tissues-, and cellular tissue-based products (HCT/P).
