

ATTENTION RIDERS

Using Your Electronic Fare



Find a card reader near bus doors or at rail stations



Tap on at card reader- wait for a green light



Board bus or train



Show card if asked by UTA Police



Tap off at card reader when you exit or transfer



Remember to tap to avoid fines of \$150 or more



ATTENTION RIDERS

TAP ON. TAP OFF.

It's easy. Just tap your electronic card to a reader located at any door of a bus or on a train platform. Look for the contactless logo to know where to touch your card.



Green: A green light on the reader means your card has been validated. Welcome aboard!

Yellow: If you get a yellow light, it means more action is required. Check the reader display for more information.

Red: A red light means your card is invalid or has been disabled. You must pay your fare using another payment method. If your Ed or Eco pass has been disabled, contact your school or employer to resolve the issue. If your credit/debit card is rejected, contact your bank or credit card company.
